Newsletter Spring 2007

Happy Spring to you all ... this has been a crazy spring with late frost, strange weather and incredible storms. It makes you wonder what the summer has in store.

In any case, I want to share with you the special discovery of the season ... the fabulous **Kullu Rosie** (aka Himalayan Ice and Pink Ice)!

This year, I made a trip to my supplier's after he returned from Tucson and was eagerly awaiting the goodies he had gotten for me. As usual, he had all of the crystals arrayed on tables when I arrived and he always starts me with some of the more usual crystals first. As we worked our way from one corner of his garage to the other, the last table contained the Kullu Rosies! I was stunned!

Many of you may have already read the write-ups, but these are amazing quartz! They are part of a new find from the Kullu Pass in Northern India, Gateway to the Himalayans and home to many temples. Quartz from this location is highly energetic and has been a rare item on eBay and the internet. All the quartz I'd ever seen from the Kullu Pass were clear and wand-like. They didn't look all that remarkable, but oh my, the energy! In my 4 years on eBay, I'd only managed to find a few of them and they sold immediately. So, imagine my shock

at seeing a table of them with astounding color and form!

Each of these points is ridged, etched and deeply pocked (nooks and crannies) like the changeling, but not quite. This type of quartz is called "convoluted" and results when the quartz is subjected to an acid bath that erodes the surfaces. Occasionally, there is evidence of growth interference, but in general, these are not growth interference quartz. And keys or dings were melted away and what resulted is a crystal that almost always is DT with contours that seem created expressly for the human hand! The surface is matte finish and the light play is nothing short of extraordinary!

Then, there's the color – rose – beautiful shades of rose! Some are more coral and some almost red, and others are a clear pink from blushed and delicate to rich and true rose! The color comes from hematite – the same thing that adds the rose color to the Brazilian Rosie, the tangerine quartz and the fabulous Orange River phantoms. Hematite is a chameleon "impurity" in quartz and can take on colors of orange, red, rose, pink, coral, salmon, russet, silver, mauve and purple! As a note, some have quite a bit of hematite coating on them and I do remove some of the "crust" when I wash each before I take pictures. Occasionally, a dealer will

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acid wash them and many of the pale, pale pink ones available have had this treatment.

Now, beyond the color, you realize that the crystals are utterly covered with trigonic record keepers – inverted and etched! If you look closely in the “joint—like” terminations, there are thousands of them ... and down the sides and in the partial faces and sides unscathed by the acid bath. This gives them amazing energy and very special meaning which I’ll explain in a bit.

Suffice to say, when these Kullu quartz were introduced at the Tucson Show in January, they were quite the hit and the limited supplies sold out extremely rapidly. Melody was actually given a crystal and was totally overjoyed with it and immediately called them “Himalayan Ice”! In a sense, they have that look (interestingly, they look very ice like when wet). But ice to me suggests cold and these crystals are anything but ... warm, loving and awesome!

Like her cousin, the Brazilian Rosie, the Kullu Rosie is exceedingly special. One thing I noted is how wide the heart opens. On the trip home from my supplier’s I held a small one in my hand and worked with her a bit – actually spent a good deal of time crying as what she unleashed was astounding - Divine love and total compassion in a depth I’d

never experienced. I felt immediately that she was an open channel to the Angelic Realm; I felt the presence of angels and heard a flutter of angel wings among her sweet songs. You can’t hold one of these quartz and not feel embraced by angel wings!

Now, the trigonics - it is said that trigonic record keepers are for a Keeper dealing with life and death issues – in other words, coming into a full understanding of the continuum of All That Is. The fact that these crystals are full of them means that the Keeper is ready for such a bridge and the important lessons that the Angelic Realm can facilitate. In using these Spirits as tools, you are aware of the lessons of the Trinity – body, mind Spirit: child, adult, elder; birth, life and death ... all must be taken in perspective in order to understand the lessons.

The color of the crystal here become key as the color is vibration. The more coral and red ones are earthier and assertive, stimulating the Core Being. These are better for a Keeper who has had difficulty assimilating the lessons of the heart into Core Self and physical action.

The pinker ones are very heart-centric and are even more profound than rose quartz in initiating a sense of selfless

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self-love. These are meant for Keepers who want to open their hearts, but hold back in fear of losing at love.

Then there are occasionally ones that have a definite mauve-pink tinge. These are the rarest and the most ethereal, bringing the mind into action and allowing it to rule with the heart.

As I said, I held a small crystal on the way home and this one has announced that she is mine (bliss!!!). I have taken her to work and slept with her every night (and I joke about feeling a bit like Wilma Flintstone – there are always crystals under my pillow!). During the first few nights, the dreams were intense and all had to do with issues I had thought were done which apparently was not the case. They have come up in lucid detail and instead of reliving the yuck of the original situation, they have resolved beautifully ... and now I am done! The dreams have abated unless another issue bubbles to the surface and then they start up again.

Interestingly, my usual angelic contact is Archangel Michael. Now, I am meeting Archangel Chamuel, Guardian of the Pink Ray. Like Michael, he is a warrior angel, but I feel a definite difference – he is a warrior of the Self – finding, revealing, expressing and living the true Self. I feel much more in touch and incredibly expanded. If I thought my

heart was open before, I've now had the equivalent of psychic open-heart surgery!

A while ago, a friend guided me through a process whereby I accepted the Sword of Michael which I wear across my back with the hilt at my shoulder (mind you, it's a psychic sword, so no worries about clumsy me cutting myself on it ...). My friend asked me to accept another, but I never got the sense that it was Michael's sword – and now I know. This one is Chamuel's and it hangs to my side. We are entering an era where Light Workers are called forward and doing what we must. Many of you are already aware and all I can say is that these are interesting times
